Festuca commutata

- Excellent red thread, leaf spot and rust tolerance
- Darker green attractive colour
- High turf value in lawns from 8-35 mm cutting height
- Good resistance to snow mold

Darker than most chewings red fescues

GREENMILE is ranked as one of the darkest chewings red fescue varieties. This can be a criteria for incorporation in some mixtures with darker varieties of other species.

A "lawn variety" par excellence

GREENMILE will perform very well in all kinds of "lawn uses" from the low cut UK lawns (10-12 mm) to the higher cut German and French lawns (2,5 - 3,5 cm).

- 7 = score for adaptation to **Extensive** use

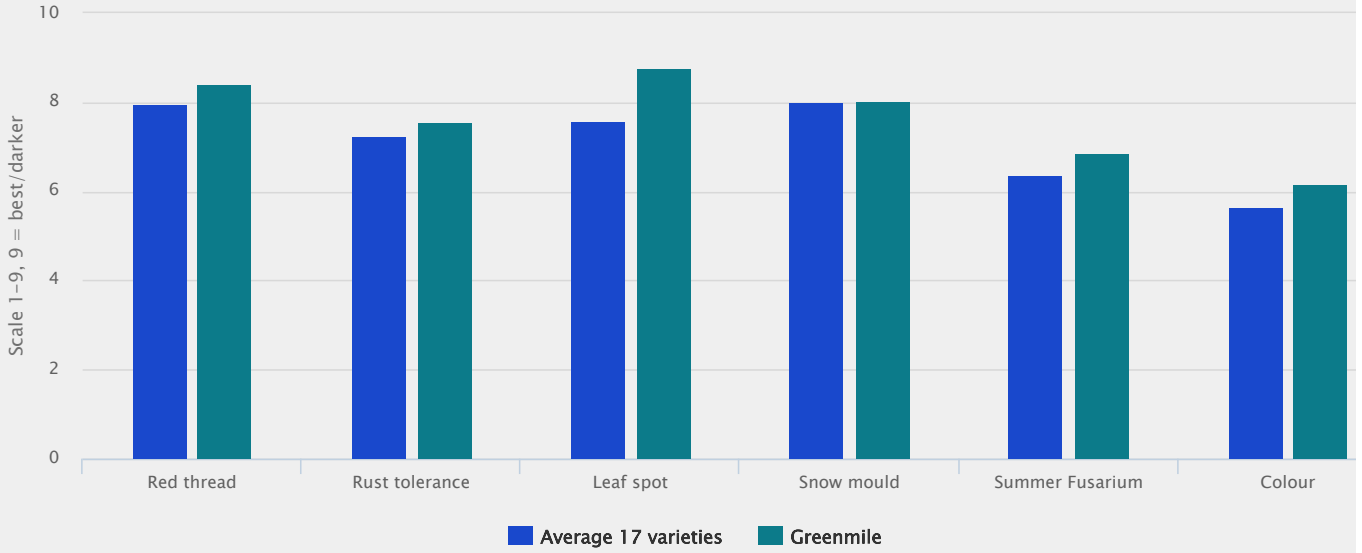

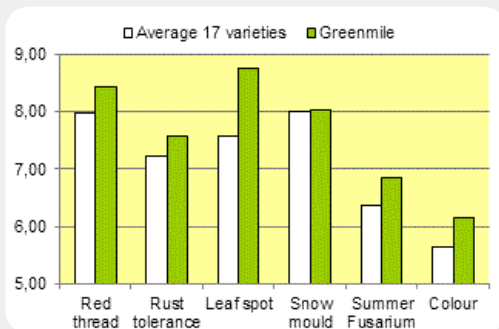
Performance in close mown lawn trials
